

Summer Reading Program

Required for the following courses:

- English I
- English II
- English III
- English IV
- General Paper – Fahrenheit 451 By Ray Bradbury with the one pager & Novel of Choice with Soundtrack Assignment
- English Language AS – Memoir Selection – see separate assignment for details & Novel of Choice with Soundtrack Assignment
- English Language A – Novel of Choice with one pager & Novel of Choice with Soundtrack Assignment
- English Literature AS & A – See separate assignment for details.

Students are required to read two books over the summer. These can be novels, literary non-fiction, or memoirs. The books must be appropriate for the student's grade and reading level. For example, popular series from elementary school are not suitable. **Suggested texts from Florida Teen Reads** are highly recommended.

Our online library, accessible through **Sora**, offers a wide range of eBooks that can be read on phones, tablets, and computers.

How to Access Sora:

- **Download the Sora App** on your phone or use Clever on your laptop.
- **Sign in** using your Pinellas County School System credentials.
 - If using Clever, you will be automatically logged in.
 - If using your phone, log in with your R2.D2 and password.

- Once logged in, you can browse and search through a variety of eBooks, magazines, and audiobooks.

Borrowing Books:

- To borrow a book, click on the book and select "Borrow."
- If the book is currently checked out, you may place a hold.
- In your library, you can return, renew, or send the book to another device.
- Content will automatically return after your loan period ends.
