Kindergarten registration begins on January 14, 2019 for the 2019-2020 school year. If you have a child who will be five years old prior to Sept. 1, 2019, you can register your child at your zoned PCS elementary school.

To register for Kindergarten for the 2019 – 2020 school year:

Be 5 years old by 9/1/19

Be able to show proof of residency (2 recent and different utilities with home address)

Have a Florida Certificate of Immunization for a five year old (shots record)

Have a physical examination certificate, within a year of starting Kindergarten.

FLU

Peak FLU season is December–March

Prevention : 1–Get the flu shot 2–Wash your hands often for at least 20 seconds with soap and warm water

3–Sanitize common work and household surfaces 4–Stay home if you are sick

Flu Fighting Tips:

Drink plenty of liquids, stay home and rest, cover coughs and sneezes with a tissue, wash your hands often, call your doctor if you have difficulty breathing, pain in your chest or stomach, dizziness and confusion

Symptoms: can begin quickly and are more severe than the common cold.
