School counselors are highly trained to embrace a comprehensive approach to optimizing student outcomes in the areas of emotional support, family intervention, social development, academic guidance, and career planning. School counselors follow guidelines and standards set by the American School Counselor Association to ensure that students are prepared for future academic, social/emotional, and career plans. At the elementary level students are beginning to develop their academic selfconcept, including attitudes about school, self, peers, social groups and families. Counselors develop a comprehensive plan to address these skills and meet the needs of all students, setting the foundation for future success. Mrs. Jennings is Bauder's School Counselor.

Message from the Clinic

With flu season underway, making healthy choices at school and at home can help prevent the flu and spreading the flu to others.

We encourage children and parents to take the following advice:

• Stay home when you are sick. Please keep your student home from school if they are not feeling well. They should be fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication. You will help prevent others from catching your illness. Avoid close contact with people who are sick.

• Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth. Germs spread this way.

Clean and disinfect surfaces or objects. Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces especially when someone is ill.

Soapy water is the best way to wash hands and to prevent the spread of germs.

Regardless of your students age please make sure your student has a spare set of clothing in their backpack. Accidents and spills happen with all age groups and the school does not always have a change of clothes.
