CLINIC REMINDERS:

WATER: With the Holiday and weather changes approaching we strongly encourage our students to bring water to school. Drinking water benefits flushing waste out of our system, constipation issues, prevent headaches and dehydration.

DOCTOR VISIT: If/when visiting the doctor's office please remember to provide the school with a note so that your student will be marked excused. If your student received a physical or vaccine always make sure to bring in a copy. ANY physical activity exclusion also needs to be brought to ensure your student sits out and heals quickly.

Hepatitis A:

Pinellas County has seen a dramatic increase in Hepatitis A cases across the county. To combat this rise in positive cases, the Florida Department of Health in Pinellas is recommending prevention and vaccination. They are offering the two-dose Hepatitis A vaccine at <u>no cost</u> to adults and children. The usual \$70.66 cost for adults is waived to remove the cost barrier; vaccines are always provided to children through age 18. No appointments are needed to get the vaccine at the DOH.
