P.E. NEWS

Parents/Guardians, please remember that students are required to wear proper footwear for Physical Education class. *Please keep your child at home if they have complaints of a sore throat and or bad continuous cough.

*Skin Rash- A note from Health Care Provider stating that your student is NOT contagious and is cleared to return to school.

*Keeping your student home when sick, will help your student get well and protect their classmates from illnesses.
