ACT

- Cost \$55 no writing- free and reduced lunch can request fee waivers
- 20-21 dates
 - June 12th deadline to register May 7th
 - July 18th deadline to register June 19th
- Anticipated dates 21-22
 - Sept 11th register by Aug 6th
 - Oct 23rd register by Sept 17
 - Dec 11th register by Nov 5th
 - Feb 12th register by Jan 7th
 - April 2nd register by Feb 25th
 - June 11th register by May 6th

- Apply during senior year
- See Mrs. Rubin for the volunteer paperwork
- Florida academic scholarship
 - 3.5 gpa 100 volunteer hours SAT 1330/ACT 29
- Florida Medallion
 - 3.0 gpa 75 volunteer hours SAT 1210/ACT 25

BRIGHT FUTURES CONTINUED

- Gold Seal
 - 3.0 gpa in non-elective high school courses
 - 3 full credit in CTE program with 3.5 unweighted gpa in courses
 - 30 volunteer hours
 - Test scores:

- Can start in October on the application
- Will need to go back in once taxes are completed to update the fafsa

NAVIANCE

- New program this year
- To do now
 - Search for potential colleges
 - Select colleges to add to the potential list
 - Research majors and careers
- Future
 - You will be applying for most colleges using common app via Naviance
 - If a school is not using common app then you still note it in Naviance

COLLEGE APPLICATIONS

- Start in July to avoid stress and missed deadlines
- Have teachers check essays before sending
- If you need a recommendation give time (a week or 2) to be completed
- Can send in a piece at a time so don't wait for test scores
- Visit potential colleges to make sure it is a good fit

COLLEGE VISIT

- Request for visit must be submitted 3 days prior to the event
- 4 visits allowed
- Must return the form within 3 days after returning from the event
- All classwork, projects, test, etc are due upon returning

CAREER AND TECHNICAL

- In the past we have been able to assist students in their job search for after high school.
