# APUSH Summer Homework 2021-2022 School Year

Welcome to AP United States History! For your summer assignment, you will not be reading a book, but interacting with US History in a different way. You are required to visit a museum, national park, or national monument this summer either in person or virtually. You must choose a place that has an exhibit dealing with some aspect of the nation's past. State history would also count as a part of our nation's past. Exhibits can depict aspects of political, economic, religious, social, intellectual, or artistic movements in United States history.

For the assignment, you will need to ...

• Write a 2 page paper, double spaced, 12 pt. Times New Roman font essay. The paper should be divided into 2 parts. PLEASE DIVIDE OUT AND LABEL EACH PART IN YOUR ESSAY (label "Part 1: Summary" on the first page and label "Part 2: whichever category that you pick" on the second page)! Each part should be 1 page, which together makes up your 2 page essay ©

o Part 1: Give a summary of the events depicted in the museum, national monument, or national park and why it is significant in American history.

o Part 2: Explain how the events depicted in the museum, national monument, or national park show how our nation has evolved today. This evolution MUST be categorized as ONE of the following: political, economic, religious, social, intellectual or artistic. Please make your category easily identifiable!!!

### The essay is due on AUGUST 11th when we return from summer break.

The museum can be in St. Petersburg, in Florida, or outside the state. For ideas, check out tourism department website from the state, or from surrounding states. You may also refer to the list of area museums and exhibits on this handout. You may visit more than one museum and multiple exhibits in a museum. (See below for museums, national parks, and national monuments nearby.)

Summary	Where did you go? What did you see? When or what time period would this historical site / museum have its historical significance?	Clear explanation of where you went as well as when the historical events depicted at the site.	Vague time period given and a brief description of the historical site. Summary	Why or how does this place (or the events that happened at this place) have an impact on our overall American history?
