As we have encountered intermittent issues with Microsoft Teams, most teachers have posted assignments in Focus as well as Teams in order to ensure that everyone has access to the work.

I'd like to ask families to also check the Tech High website regularly for updates that may be important. Ms. Howard has posted attendance procedure guidelines for your reference and there is a lot of great information there.

Last week, teachers were able to post assignments and recorded lessons in Microsoft Teams and students had a chance to get familiar with the new platform. This week, teachers have been authorized to start doing live lessons so it is more important than ever for students to attend their classes every day.

Every teacher has open office hours from 11:00 - 11:30 am and from 2:30 - 3:30 pm Monday – Thursday. Each Friday (with the exception of this Friday, 4/10) every teacher has open office hours from 8:30 am -3:30 pm. Any student who is struggling with an assignment or needs individual support should reach out to their teacher(s) during open office hours to get the help they need to be successful.

This Friday is a non-school day. Students will not be expected to check in for attendance and teachers will not be working. Students will be expected to check in with each of their classes for attendance purposes on Friday 4/17 and every subsequent Friday.
