We hope you are doing well, staying healthy, and preparing to start the 4th grading period in a digital format starting **Monday**, **March 30th**. We are all working hard to adapt to our new way of work and this communication will hopefully provide some answers to questions you may have. Before I share these important points, I'd like to just say that I am so proud of our staff, students and families for the flexibility and attention to best practices that we have seen and will continue to see throughout this challenge. We are pioneers in this circumstance and working together, we will help each other through every obstacle. We sorely miss our students and we all look forward to getting back to our school routines.

Here is some important info for students and families:

- 1.) We distributed lots of computers yesterday to families in need. We will continue to distribute computers until 3:00 today, (March 25). If there is a special need to get a computer outside of this window of time, call our school today to make arrangements for pickup. Families who pick up a computer will be given a paper outlining the process for accessing free WiFi through Spectrum.
- 2.) Grades for the 3rd grading period will be finalized by Friday and report cards will be available to view in Focus on Monday, April 6th. A hard copy of the report card will not be made available for the 3rd grading period.
- 3.) Getting started in Microsoft Teams: Please check the Tech High website often to stay informed with any new information that may be useful to you. The link below will also provide a tutorial on how to get started in MS teams

4.) All students should log into Microsoft Teams by noon on Thursday (3/26/20) to check in and ensure that they have access. Program teachers have posted a 1 question assignment asking students to simply verify that they have connected.

The rest of this week should be used to get familiar with Teams and verify connection through the check-in assignment through program classes. Please access Microsoft Teams by noon on Thursday, March 26th to respond to the assignment posted in your program class.

5.) Starting March 30th, students will log in to each class DAILY. There is a class schedule posted below and we strongly encourage students to attend each class in real time in order to participate in discussions via chat.

- 7.) Parents, we strongly encourage you to ensure that your child treats this new way of work as much like a regular school day as possible. Establishing set routines and timelines will help to ensure success and set the purpose for engaging with academic content. As a school, we have developed strong processes for eliminating the distractions presented by personal electronics. We recommend that you implement the same policies from home to give your student the best opportunity to fully engage with the material being taught. We would like to request that electronic devices not used for accessing MS Teams be made inaccessible while students are attending their daily classes.

We know that this new process will be a challenge at first. We have encouraged all of our teachers to start slowly and provide time for everyone to get familiar with this new way of work. As we become more comfortable, we will continue to provide supports and address any issues as they arise.
