Action Steps

Become familiar with the BEST design in order to understand what students are expected to master.

Action Steps

Implement monthly Running Records

Strengthen student inquiry skills through the implementation and monitoring of routine use of higher-level thinking through questioning, class discussions, problem solving activities, and/or collaborative study groups

Implement a plan for identifying students not meeting benchmark in the early grades, including targeted instruction, and frequently monitoring progress to identify and address gaps early
