Some of the services I provide are...

- . Teach classroom guidance lessons in the academic, career and social emotional domains which area aligned with the Florida Standards and the American School Counseling Association mindsets and behaviors
- . Provide individual and group counseling on various topics such as changing families, anger management, conflict resolution, grief, getting along with others, building self-esteem, etc.
- . Consult with teachers and parents to assist in meeting individual student needs
- . Coordinate referrals to school and community agencies
- . Run the Terrific Kids Club (TKC)-positive incentive student recognition program
- . Implement behavior interventions to assist with student behavioral needs
- . Oversee the Students Against Violence Everywhere (SAVE) Promise Club (see below)

SAVE Promise Clubs are an initiative of Sandy Hook Promise and help to fulfill the mission of creating a culture engaged in preventing, shootings, violence and other harmful acts in schools. These students will be leaders of change and have great impact with their peer groups to create a more caring and connected school community. The SAVE Club will organize activities, presentations and events that reinforce the important lessons learned through Sandy Hook Promise and create a culture of looking out for one another, being upstanders and preventing violence.
