


How would you rate the overall quality of the education at your child's school? (N=15)





























How strongly do you agree or disagree with the following statements?




















## **Factors Driving School NPS**


How do the following areas impact your rating of your child's school?

If you had a family member or friend moving to the area, how likely are you to recommend Pinellas County Schools? (N=15)




### **Factors Driving District NPS**

How do the following areas impact your rating of Pinellas County Schools?










