

## **Progress Monitoring 1 Testing**

### **STAR Testing (Grades K - 2)**

STAR testing window is from <u>Monday, August 25 - Friday,</u> <u>September 26</u>.

 Your child's teacher will inform you of their respective testing dates for ELA and Math



### **FAST Testing (Grades 3 - 5)**

FAST PM1 testing window is Tuesday, September 2 - Friday, September 26.

Your child's teacher will inform you of their respective testing dates for ELA and Math



Parents, guardians, and students must remember that Progress Monitoring (PM) 1 assessments are testing students on content they will learn over the course of this school year. PM1 scores are expected to be lower than the scores your child attained at the end of last school year. Your child's teacher(s) will use this baseline data from PM1 to inform instruction moving forward. We anticipate Progress Monitoring 2 scores to be higher when students sit for the assessments in December. When students take the May FAST and STAR assessments, they will have learned all of the content and should score their best.


