FAIR SHARE ACCOUNT - Supporting your student's full Academy Experience

"Fair Share account" is your student's individual fundraising account that collects the funds that you or your student earn by participating in various preapproved fundraising activities or through payments made directly into your student's account by check or cash. The funds collected in your student's "Fair Share Account" transfer from year to year and are available to be applied to the costs of various academic activities. Once your student graduates, any unused funds are transferred into the AOF General Account or a younger sibling's account. Unused funds cannot be surrendered to any parent or student.

For your student to receive his/her % of the Auction proceeds into their Fair Share account:

1. Sell a **minimum of 3 Auction tickets per student**. Checks may be sent to school made out to NEHI and your student can bring your tickets home. (Feel free to sell more than 3!)

AND

2. Donate at least 1 item for auction, **minimum \$25 value per student**. (This could be a basket of auctionable items valued at \$25 or one item of at least \$25 value) Send donation to school with a completed donation slip attached to your donation. The slip is on the school website, AOF tab---Student/Parent section.

AND

3. *Donate some time!* Volunteer to support our preparation and marketing efforts in one of the approved activities (all opportunities of need will be outlined during the Parent meetings and via email & website updates) *Time requirements:*

One-student family: **7 volunteer hours** toward the auction per family (parent &/or student combined) Multi-student families: **7 volunteer hours** for first student plus **3 hours** for **each additional student**.

OR

1. Satisfy requirements #1 and #2 above.

AND

2. Donate some time **and money!** If you're short on time, you may "buy out" <u>four</u> of your required volunteer hours. You will still be required to volunteer to support our preparation and marketing efforts in one of the approved activities (all opportunities of need will be outlined during the Parent meetings and via email updates), but your time commitment will be reduced. **Time & money requirements:**

Donate \$100 in place of 4 volunteer hours. (this donation goes to the general Auction proceeds account) PLUS...

One-student family: Work 3 volunteer hours

Multi-student families: Work 3 volunteer hours for first student plus 3 hours for each additional student.
