- Keep their laptop and materials at their home or place of residence for the entirety of the 2022-2023 school year.
- Return the school assigned laptop and materials to Bay Point Middle School at the close of the school year, in May 2023. In extenuating circumstances, the assigned laptop and materials may be required to be returned to the BPMS campus during the school year.
- Maintain responsibility for the laptop and be a role model for positive digital citizenship throughout the duration of the 2022-2023 school year according to our PCS Connects guidelines.
- Pay for the replacement or repairs of the assigned laptop and materials in the event of loss or damage.
