AUTOMOTIVE ACADEMY

Northeast High School's Automotive Academy combines technical, academic and workplace skills in an integrated curriculum in accordance with all National Automotive Technicians Education Foundation, Inc. (NATEF) guidelines. Students have the opportunity to earn nationally recognized Institute for Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) certifications and the Florida Automobile Dealers Association (FADA) Certified Technician certification.

The Academy is designed as a three to four-year course of study that prepares students for postsecondary education and the workplace. As students in a college preparatory program, qualified students may be eligible for Gold Seal

de Scholarships.

The automotive industry is a major sponsor of the Automotive Academy at Northeast High School. Local industry partners work closely with the Academy in an advisory role. They provide continuing technical education to the Academy team and make recommendations concerning the academic and technical curriculum necessary for student success.







AUTOMOTIVE MAINTENANCE AND LIGHT REPAIR

The Automotive Maintenance and Light Repair program focuses on understanding and demonstrating the skills necessary to successfully perform common maintenance and light repair tasks. Students are introduced to the principles of engine performance systems, transmission systems, steering and suspension systems, brakes, heating and air conditioning, and electrical systems. Students learn how to service, troubleshoot, diagnose, and repair engine systems. The program stresses understanding and demonstration of the following elements of the automotive industry: planning; management; finance; technical and product skills; underlying principles of technology, labor issues, community issues; and health, safety, and environmental issues.
