What you need to know...

- Students should arrive at the bus stop 10 minutes before pickup time.
- Students should remain at the bus stop up to 30 minutes after the scheduled pickup time before their bus is considered late.
- Parents are responsible for providing the necessary assistance and protection for their child while going to and from the bus stop.
- Parents are responsible for providing the necessary supervision of the child at the bus stop.
- Students are to get on and off the bus at the same assigned bus stop each day.
- If your child's address has changed, contact your child's school.
