Scholars' artwork is saved each year through grade 8 and you can access and view their online gallery with parent/guardian approval. All scholars in Pinellas County Schools have online access to the Scholastic Art Magazine (a new edition is released every other month) https://art.scholastic.com/. They also have access to over 30 past issues and projects associated with featured artists in the magazine. The articles are written and geared for scholars in grades 4 and above. Just click log in, choose 'I am a student' and enter our classroom code: OzonaArtist

Scholar success in Art:

Visual art classrooms in Pinellas County use standards-based art lessons and a 1-4 scaled visual rubrics to grade and adjudicate artwork. Level 4 is the highest and level 1 lowest on the standard-based grading spectrum. We discuss how to achieve at least a level 3 (grade level standard) and how to go above and beyond to reach level 4.

Grades: Level 4= Excellence (always meeting and/or exceeding standards), Level 3= Very Good (consistently meets standards), Level 2=S/C (mostly meets standards –but needs assistance) & Level 1= Needs Improvement or 'Unsatisfactory for grades or behavior are for those scholars who are not meeting/trying standards/behaviors.

5th grade scholars will take an end of course assessment for both music and art.
