

Hall of Fame Criteria

Alumni

A nominee may not be considered until five years after graduation from Northeast High School and must qualify in at least three of the areas identified below:

1. High School All-American
2. All-State
3. Holder of a School record(s)
4. Played Collegiate Sports
5. Earned a College Athletic Scholarship
6. Pinellas County "Player of the Year"
7. Pinellas County "Player of the Week"
8. All Conference, All County, All District, All Region, All Suncoast, or All City
9. Played professionally or post-graduation participation in a national and/or international level of sporting competition
10. Drafted by a professional team or received a post-graduate invitation and/or international sporting competition
11. Brought post-graduate recognition to Northeast through accomplishments in areas unrelated to their sport
12. Displayed good sportsmanship

**A candidate who does not meet the stated criteria and who, by a vote of 75% of the committee, may be recognized for the Northeast High School Hall of Fame.*

Coaches

The coach may not be a current member of the Northeast High School coaching staff and must be out of coaching at Northeast for a minimum of three years. The coach must qualify in at least two of the following areas:

1. Had a positive win/loss record
2. Brought positive recognitions in terms of accomplishments; Conference, District, Regional, or State Championships
3. Was a good sportsman or displayed good sportsmanship
4. Brought positive recognition to Northeast through accomplishments in areas other than athletics.
