Hall of Fame Criteria

Alumni

A nominee may not be considered until five years after graduation from Northeast High School and must qualify in at least three of the areas identified below:

- 1. High School All-American
- 2. All-State
- 3. Holder of a School record(s)
- 4. Played Collegiate Sports
- 5. Earned a College Athletic Scholarship
- 6. Pinellas County "Player of the Year"
- 7. Pinellas County "Player of the Week"
- 8. All Conference, All County, All District, All Region, All Suncoast, or All City
- 9. Played professionally or post-graduation participation in a national and/or international level of sporting competition
- 10. Drafted by a professional team or received a post-graduate invitation and/or international sporting competition
- 11. Brought post-graduate recognition to Northeast through accomplishments in areas unrelated to their sport
- 12. Displayed good sportsmanship

*A candidate who does not meet the stated criteria and who, by a vote of 75% of the committee, may be recognized for the Northeast High School Hall of Fame.

Coaches

The coach may not be a current member of the Northeast High School coaching staff and must be out of coaching at Northeast for a minimum of three years. The coach must qualify in at least two of the following areas:

- 1. Had a positive win/loss record
- 2. Brought positive recognitions in terms of accomplishments; Conference, District, Regional, or State Championships
- 3. Was a good sportsman or displayed good sportsmanship
- 4. Brought positive recognition to Northeast through accomplishments in areas other than athletics.
