Marshall awarded honor for outstanding service

Every year, the Ned March Award honors two police officers for outstanding service to the community. Ned March was a citizen who was concerned about the safety of the community. This award was established in his honor.

One of this year's recipients is Detective Bill Marshall, Northeast's School Resource officer. Marshall has been working with students for the past eight years.

"I've always enjoyed working with students. I chose to work in the juvenile department a long time ago," said Marshall. "Working with students has its advantages and disadvantages, but the advantages outweigh the disadvantages by a landslide," he added.

Marshall became a School Resource Officer eight years ago when the school system wanted him for Northeast—and he accepted.

"It was really a mutual decision more than anything," said Marshall.

For the past 16 years, Marshall has been in law enforcement. He also received the school Resource Officer of the year award in the past.

"I am greatly honored to have received these awards," said Marshall. "It is always nice to receive recognition for the work you do. It lets you know you are being appreciated."

Assistant principal Rick Misenti said, "He (Marshall) has promoted the respect we have at this school for law enforcement."

Marshall says he feels that working with NEHI students is rewarding.

"I get to know a lot of good kids. So often in law enforcement we see the bad kids. This way I get to know the good ones too," he said.

In four years, Marshall plans to retire and teach criminal justice or law enforcement, the subject in which he has a master's degree.

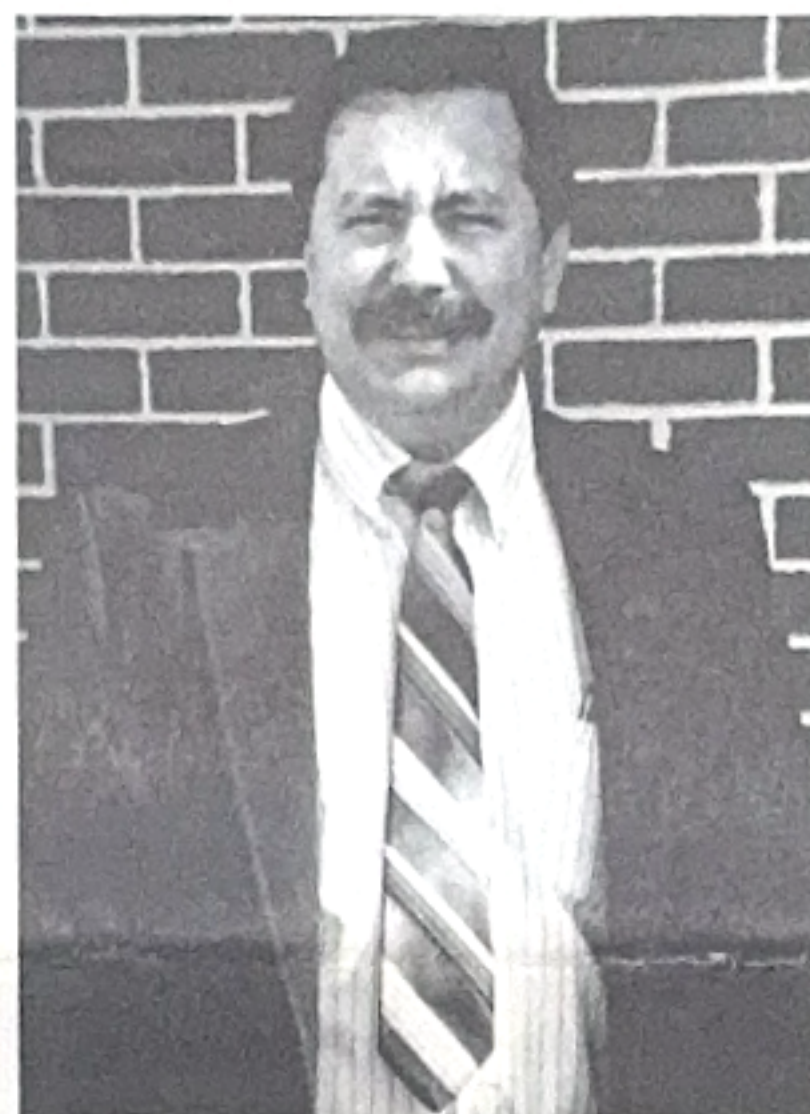

Continuing a tradition that has been going on for the past 28 years, Interact club is currently having its annual Christmas tree sale.

On December second, a truckload of Blue Spruce, Scotch Pine, and Douglas Fir Christmas trees arrived at the front of the school and were set up at the old bus circle.

All of the members of Interact are assigned to a shift to sell the trees, which are being sold from 3:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. during the week, and from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Saturdays and Sundays. The

price of the trees range from four to seven dollars a foot.

"The sale benefits the school more than any other fundraiser," according to Earl Wilson, head of Interact. The club brought in over \$10,000 from the sale last year.

All club members are required to participate in the sales or risk losing their membership in Interact.

"The members not only give their 100 percent of effort in the sale, but they look forward to it," said Wilson.

Seniors Lee Feldman and Keith Fredericks are chairmen of the sale.

Said Feldman, "We are all excited about the sales. It puts us all in the Christmas spirit."

On December 5, for the sixth consecutive year, the forty-three members of NEHI's Fine Arts Club, spread Christmas cheer throughout the All Children's Hospital, where many ill children must resort to during the holiday.

"We would like to thank the Fine Arts Club for their long, hard work in transforming the hospital into a Christmas wonderland for the children," says Luci Weber, director of the Child Life Department at the hospital.

The Art Club took a day off from their schoolday routine to travel to the hospital. There they hung large paper wreath designs, ornaments, and stained glass, all of which were prepared by the students in their art classes. The students also painted the hospital's windows and used a special formula in the paint so it can be washed off easily after the holiday.

"The Art Club has three major goals: to serve the school, to serve the individual and to serve the community," said Mrs. Burwell, an art teacher at NEHI, as well as the sponsor of the Art Club.

In all of Burwell's classes, her students participated in four weeks of hard work, preparing the decorations for the hospital.

"Only the Art Club members may go on this trip, but all of my students, and some of Mr. Ted Eichmann's (another art instructor) student's create various things. The student's are free to express their own ideas and they all receive an A for their contributions."

How did this tradition start? The actual reason for this project to have begun was because it is required of the National Art Honor Society to serve in a com-

munity project, but to the students, it has turned into much more than a requirement.

"It's a gift. They are actually giving a gift," said Burwell, "it is hard to work on a piece of art for such a long time and know that you will never see your masterpiece again. All of the art club members will allow the patients to keep their artwork."

During their visit, the students will also have a chance to tour the nursery, the intensive care unit, the post-operative care unit and the out-patient unit.

"The hospital really appreciates this. It gives everyone a

lift. It's really a sharing thing and I think it is wonderful. Each year the hospital can't wait for the Art Club to come. When I call and ask if we can come, they really get excited and look forward to it," said Burwell.

"This whole project takes a lot of time and effort. It requires cooperation from everyone. I would especially like to thank all of the teachers for releasing the students to go, Sue Wedding for chaperoning, and Cathy Burns, a former student of NEHI, for providing the cardboard supplied by Kane's Furniture.

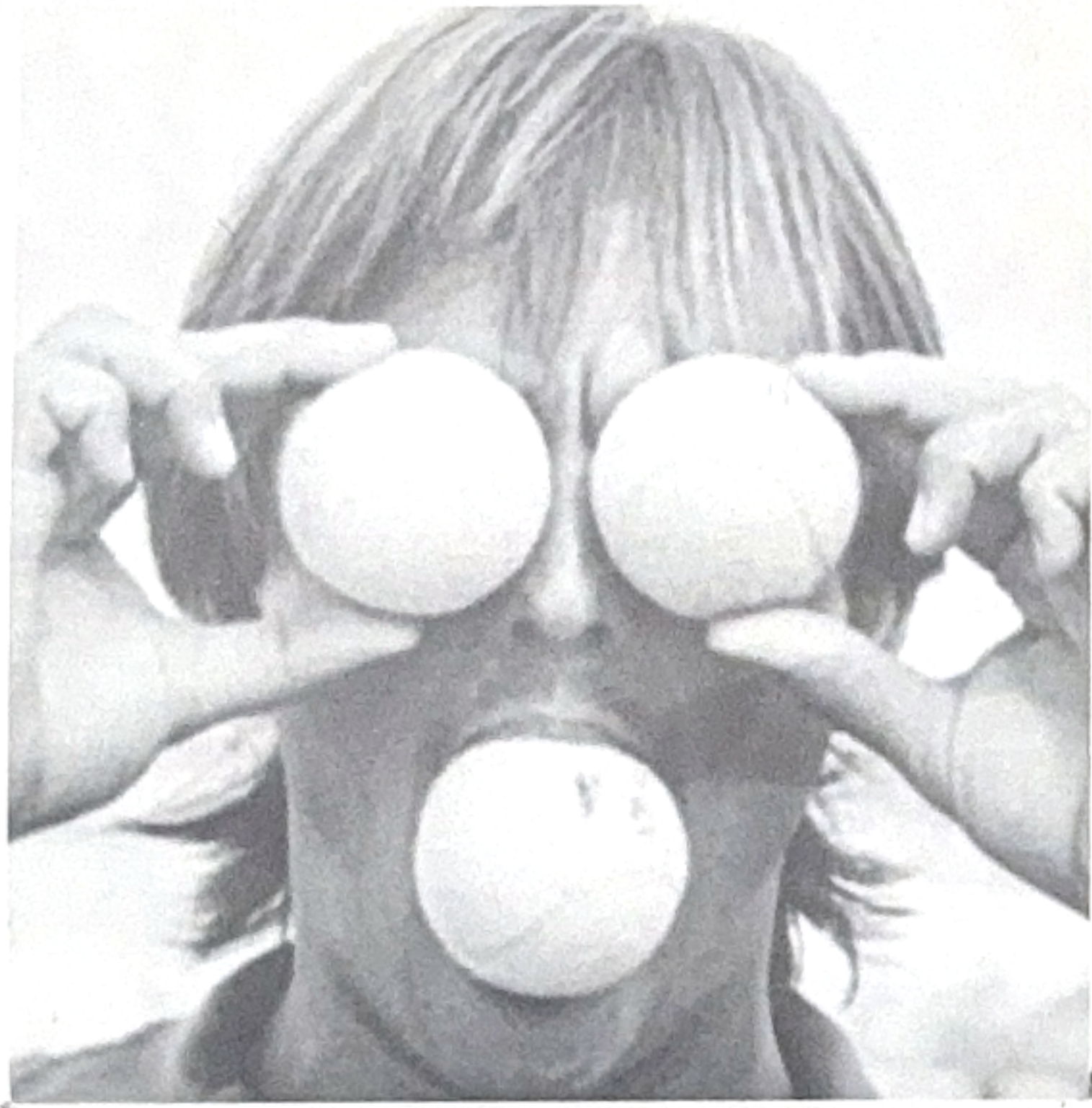

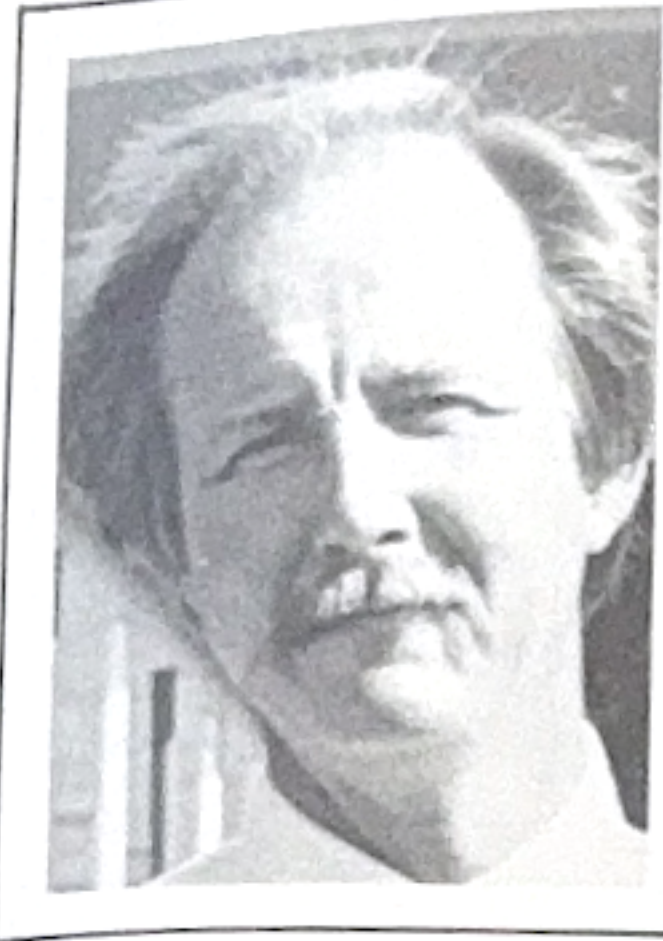

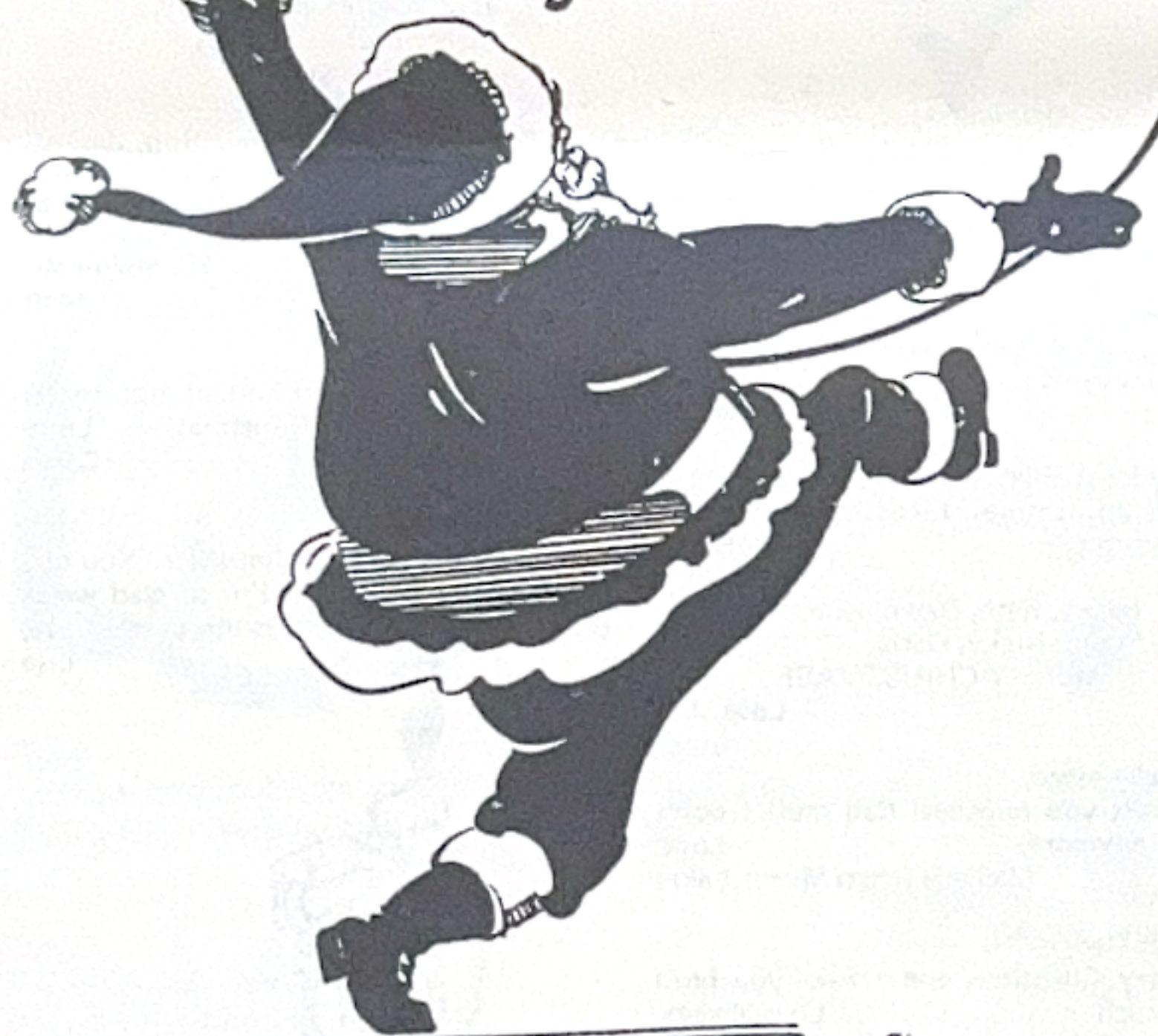

Driving drunk: the S.A.D.D. statistics

Driving drunk is a subject face by any people many times a year, especially during the Christmas season. Students Against Driving Drunk (SADD) is trying to reduce or even eliminate this subject as a household word.

SADD has four major goals: to eliminate the drunk drivers to save lives; to alert high school students of drinking and driving; to conduct community alcohol awareness programs; to organize peer counseling to help students who may have concerns about alcohol.

SADD, according to vice-president of the NEHI chapter Denise Gibbons, was formed in 1981 by Robert Anastas after hockey players he coached were killed in a automobile accident which involved drunk driving. SADD is now in six thousand schools across the United States and Canada.

Most people do not realize the dangers involved with driving drunk and that it could lead to death. Drinking and driving

can, not only, lead to death or other physical harm, but it leads to legal problems. The penalties for driving drunk include the loss of your drivers license, a jail sentence, and/or, even worse, the grave.

According to state law, if you have a 10 blood alcohol content (BAC), you are drunk. In some states it's against the law to have a BAC of .05 to .09 and operate a motor vehicle. It is wise to wait thirty minutes to an hour before driving with every drink you have. Every one after that you should wait another hour.

People who drink regularly may have a BAC of .10, by legal definition be intoxicated, but not appear drunk. These people have learned to control what they do and say.

There are a lot of myths about how to make a drunk sober. Coffee does not make a person sober. Exercise, cold showers, and especially cold swims, which can be fatal, are all not solutions. The only thing that can cure alcohol consumption is time.

A drink is considered, by state law, a twelve ounce can of beer, one and a half

ounces of eighty-proof distilled spirits, or a five ounce glass of wine, which has a twelve percent alcohol content.

Last year 27,500 people in the U.S. lost their lives because of drunk driving.

There are ways to drink yet be safe. Know your one-drink-per-hour limit, don't leave the party until you know the alcohol has left your body. If this is not possible, call a taxi or take the bus. If you find a person who you can trust not to get drunk make him the designated driver.

If you are hosting a party, there are ways to ensure safe rides home. Serve other drinks such as coffee or soft drinks, avoid serving salty foods, don't pressure people to drink if they don't want to, arrange transportation for alcohol impaired people or encourage them to stay the night.

The SADD program will be having a SADD Day soon and may be having a Christmas project. For moving information, contact chapter president, Marc Centeno, or vice-president, Denise Gibbons.

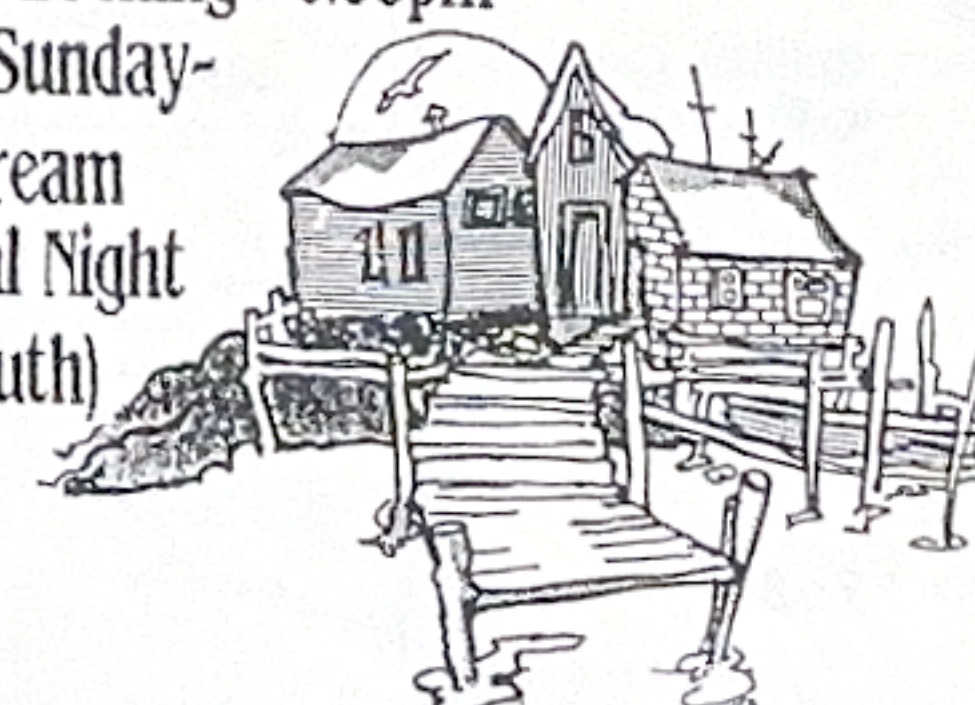

Despite slow start, varsity football finishes 6-4

When one thinks of the word "comeback", what usually comes to mind is a team or an individual returning to his normal performance after one or possibly two major setbacks or defeats.

Most of the time when a team loses four straight games in the beginning of a season, the whole thing usually goes belly up.

But that was just not the case with this year's varsity football team. Head coach Jerry Austin's squad fought back from four consecutive losses in its first four games to finishing with a winning record of 6-4.

The main reason for the turnaround midway through the season was the return of previously injured quarterback, Bobby Byrd.

Byrd was injured in the second game of the season with Gibbs. He returned to his role as starting quarterback against Cape Coral, the first game the Vikings won.

In his six starts as quarterback, Byrd threw for a total of nine touchdowns and led the Vikings to six victories.

Golden caught another pass along with touchdown runs of 10 and 14 yards by Jerome Calloway. Kenny Bryant also ran one in to make the score 35-3.

The Vikes returned home to play the second to last game of the season as they shut out Dixie Hollins 28-0.

The duo of Byrd throwing to Golden turned out to be a deadly combination providing 20 of the 28 Viking points.

Calloway had runs of 11 and 33 yards, Bryant scored on a 9 yard run and Golden caught a 28 yard pass from Bryant.

"We feel that we played just about as good as anyone this past month," commented Austin. Bryant and Golden led the Viking offensive attack with seven touchdowns. Calloway had four and Jon Martin, Gary Gainer, and Byrd had one. Jeff Gigante had four field goals and converted 21 of 22 extra points.

McCullough places first at state swim meet

Northeast High's swim team had a very successful day on November 24, at the state swim meet. Three of the team members especially excelled, one taking first place, and two taking two second places.

John McCullough, a senior, had an unexpected victory in the 100 breaststroke, placing first. McCullough also placed first in the district meet on November 17, and also during the preliminaries the morning before the state swim meet that morning.

"I really didn't expect a victory due to an injury three weeks before. I bruised my ribs and I couldn't train for a week and a half."

McCullough also broke the school record for the same event. The old record stood at a 1:02.27, and McCullough finished with a 59.81.

"Before the race, I was very nervous, but afterwards I was really surprised."

Another male competitor which placed second in two races was junior David McDaniel. McDaniel placed second in the 200 freestyle and the 500 freestyle. In the 200 McDaniel broke his own school record, finishing with a 1:40.2. He also broke Bill Grimke's record, a graduate of NEHI, finishing with a 4:30.1.

"I was really mad after racing the 500m. My electronic timing system broke and the coaches had to switch to hand held clocks, which makes the time not as exact. I lost by a second, and it could've made a big difference," said McDaniel.

For the girls' team, Dana Dutcher was the highest achiever. She placed second in two events: the 50 freestyle and the 100 freestyle, finishing with times 23.5 and 50.9.

In the girls' relay event, Northeast came in in eleventh place. The team consisted of swimmers seniors Carrie Bullington and Dutcher, junior Allyson Hamric,

and sophomore Stacey Spencer. The team swam against 31 other teams and broke the old school record, finishing with a 3:52.

"I was very much surprised. I, like all other Pinellas coaches, did not expect John to win, because the favorites were Dana Dutcher and David McDaniel, but in spite of this, we are of course very proud," said Fred Ulrich, the swim team coach.

One thing that is required of the swimmers is to shave the hair off of large portions of their bodies. 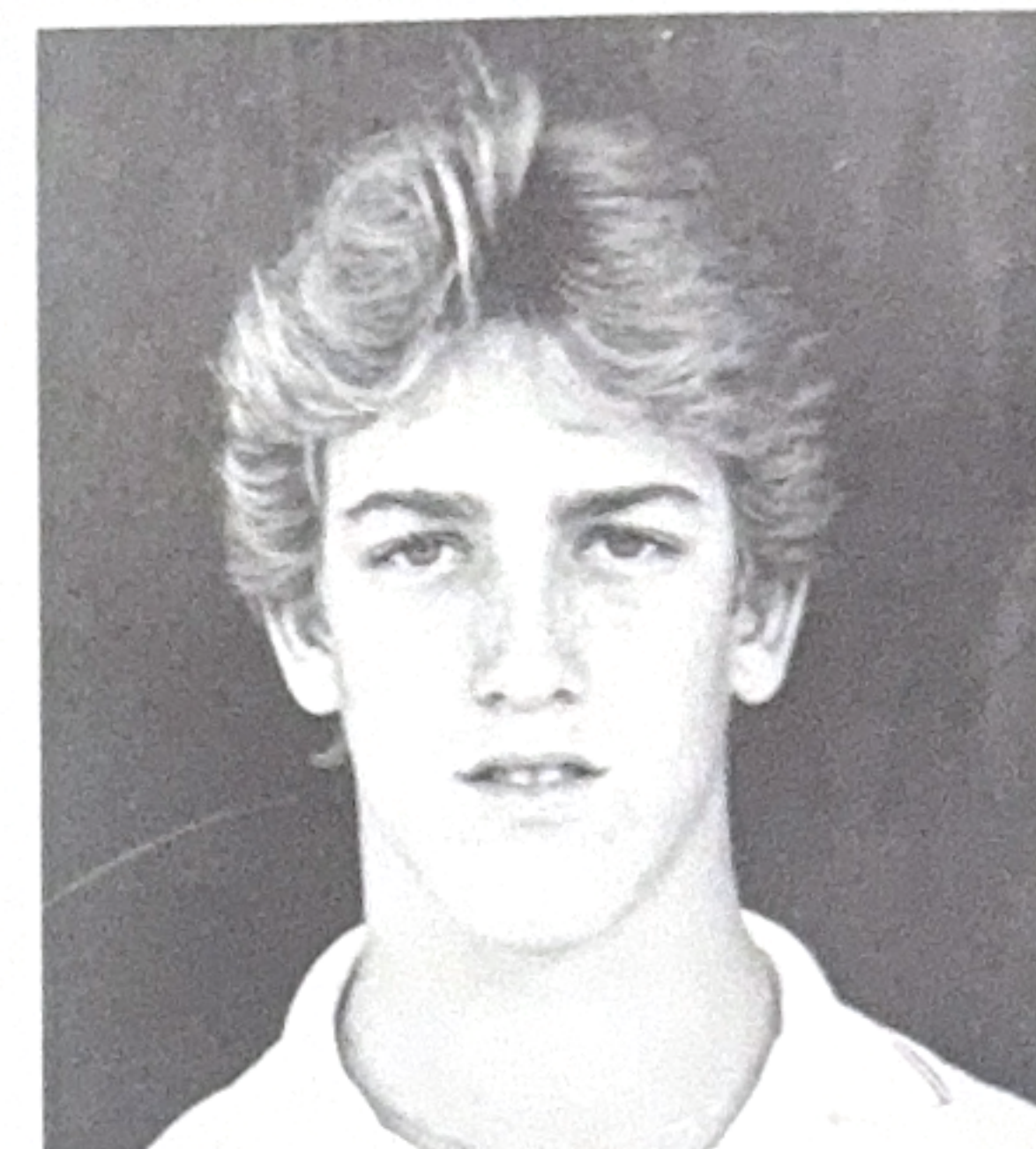

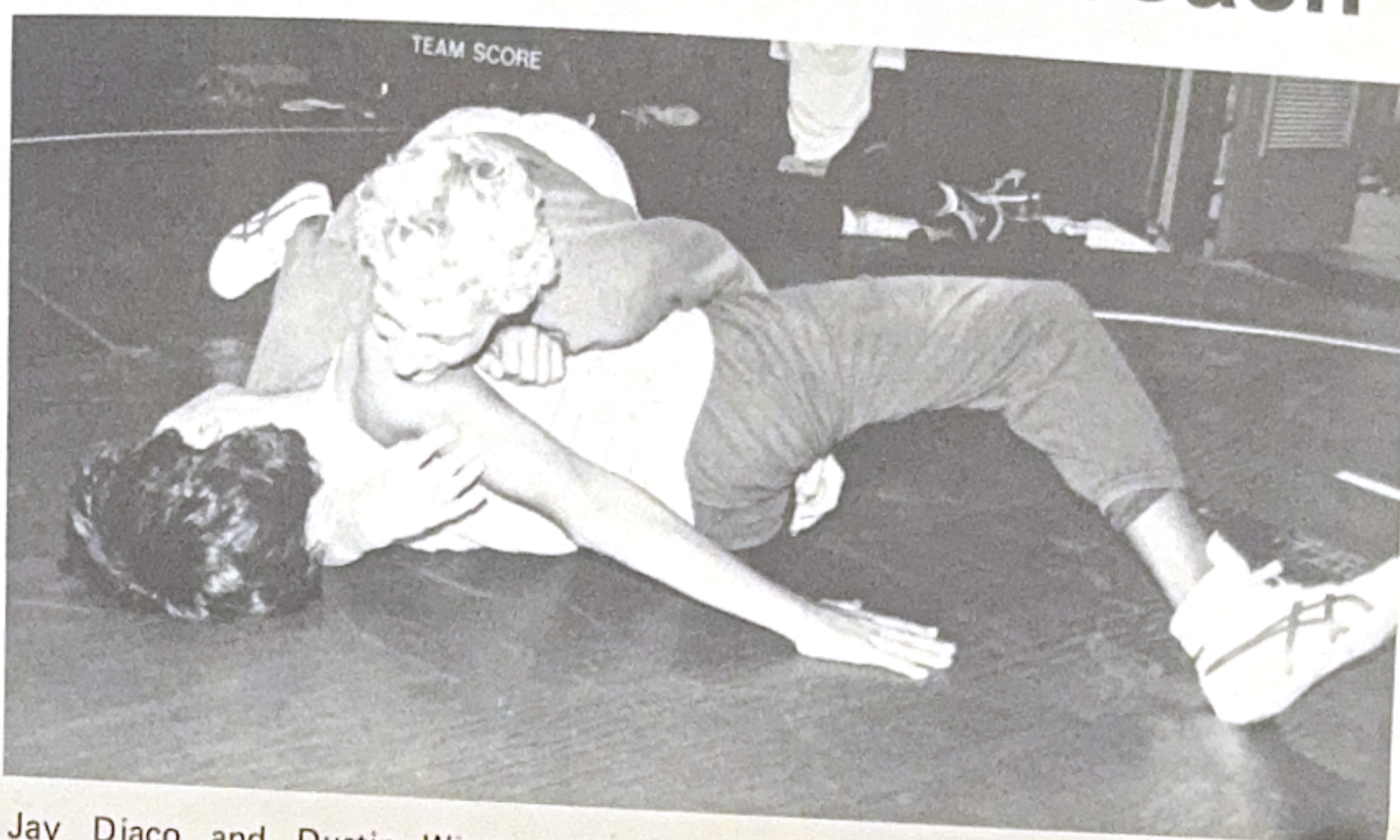
The team is currently training up to two and one half hours after school. The 28 team members say they want to be in shape for their rough season ahead.
