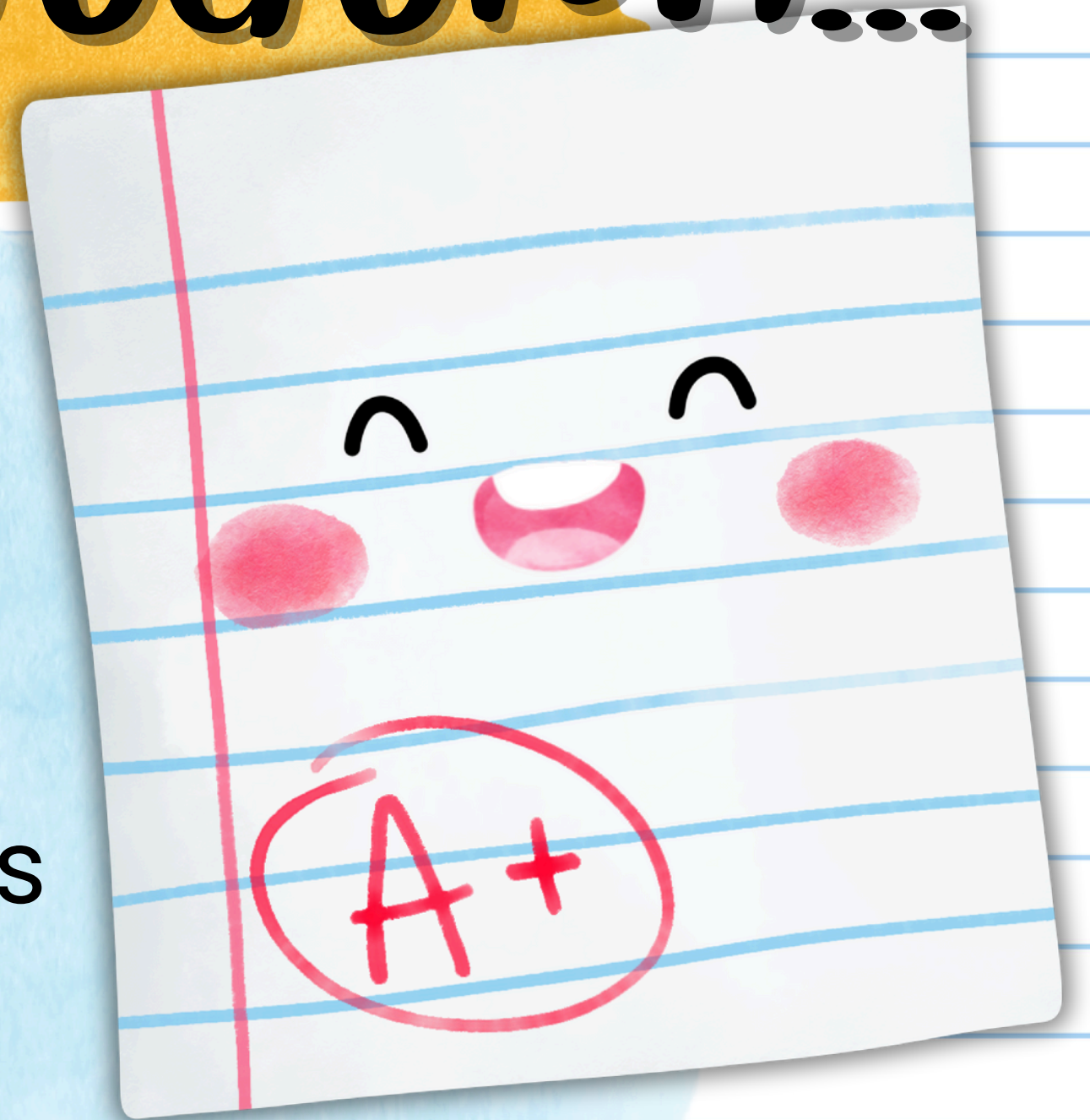

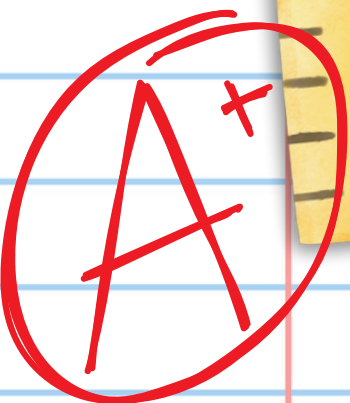

what is inclement weather?

Inclement weather is when it is unsafe for students to be outside.

This includes a shelter-in-place order, a thunderstorm with documented lightning strikes, or a torrential downpour.

In a regular Florida rainstorm, students will dismiss regularly.



Official Dismissal Time

Morgan Fitzgerald Middle School's official dismissal time is 4:10pm.

During inclement weather, we will start dismissal as soon as 3:45, when it is safe for students to leave. This is to allow walkers and bike riders time to get home safely if necessary and to ease the strain on the system, for speed and efficiency.



How will we know?

You will know that we are running an inclement weather dismissal by call/text/email, through our Focus system, by **3:50** on the day of.

Please make sure your contact info is correct in Focus so we can reach you.



Car Rider Dismissal

- 1.)Parents enter campus via 66th street/west entrance/bus circle. You will be pulling in the “bus circle.”
- 2.)Parents pull in the driveway on WEST side of campus (the “bus circle”). Parents drive as far up as they can. Parents can fill up the driveway all the way down and back up to the street (completely full driveway). If the driveway is full parents will be directed by the SRO to wait at PPHS until driveway clears enough for more cars. Parents should not back up into 118th Street – if the driveway is full, they should pull past the driveway to wait in the PPHS parking lot for cars to exit the driveway.
- 3.)Parents enter their child’s name using the link on the following slide, the QR code, or the link and QR off the website. and a brief description of their location (ex: “Suzy Phantom, by number 3” or “Johnny Blue, in the circle part”)
- 4.)If a parent needed assistance with the link, they should wave down the AP that is on the car line assisting with dismissal. That AP will assist with entering the student’s name for them. If a parent is able to enter the name themselves, they do not need to communicate with the adult on the bus circle.
