Academic Achievements

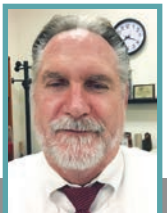
- Improved school grade in the 2017-2018 school year from an F to a C. Significant increases in ELA and Math learning gains and Civics proficiency led to the jump in school grade.
- Overall school attendance rate continues to improve and hovers above 90% consistently
- Percentage of 7th grade students proficient in Math increased by 18%. This represents the highest percent increase among middle schools in our district
- Percentage of 8th grade students proficient in Math increased by 14 percent, this represents the second highest percent increase amongst middle schools.
- School improved its Civics proficiency by 20%, which was the highest percent increase amongst middle schools. There has been consistent years of proficiency growth at Azalea Middle School.
