Digital Learning Device Process

Before leaving campus:

1. We will login with your child's student login (domain credentials, R2.D2).
2. Please note, you can drive to any Pinellas County School and get on their WIFI (PCSB-Wireless). You will need to be somewhat close to connect to the building.
3. If you have any problems, please feel free to email Ms. Crosley at crosleyj@pcsb.org.

At Home:

All school devices are set to connect to PCSB-Wireless by default. When you take your device home, the device is not going to know about the wireless networks at your house. Parents are going to need to connect the device to your home network, just like you would any of your other devices before you can start using them.

To Access Teams
