The Graphic Arts Academy provides students with four years of instruction blending graphic arts and technology. Students in the academy can choose to concentrate in COMMERCIAL ART, FILMMAKING, GAMING DESIGN/3D ANIMATION, or DIGITAL MUSIC PRODUCTION. While fulfilling graduation requirements, students will be well prepared to enter a career in the graphic arts industry or a post-secondary school to continue their studies. Classes are taught in labs fitted with industry-grade, modern technology. Students and teachers work closely together with business partners who provide consultation, job shadowing, and apprenticeship opportunities. Successful completion of this program will allow students to be eligible for the Florida Bright Futures scholarships and other scholarship opportunities. The Film Program naturally integrates the music, performing arts, fine arts, technology, and English disciplines. The program's curriculum revolves around film production as a medium, requiring all students to receive training in screenwriting, film scoring, storyboarding, acting, directing, photography, special and practical effects, and cinematography. Students will use industry standard cameras, equipment and software in the production of traditional films, documentaries, commercials, stop motion animations, traditional animations and other forms of non-traditional filmmaking. Students graduating from the Film Program go on to work in the fields of filmmaking, video editing, advertising, animation, event management, broadcasting (TV), and photography.





Commercial Art

CERTIFICATIONS: Adobe Photoshop, Illustrator, & InDesign

The Commercial Art Program focuses on logo design, photography, graphic design, digital art, outdoor design, typography, product design, and packaging design in the development of marketing and advertising campaigns. The students explore multiple forms of printing including screen printing, digital printing, and press operations. State-of-the-art equipment including DSLR cameras, lighting equipment, and software are used for students to develop real-world skill and professional-level work. Students graduating from the Commercial Art program go on to work in the fields of graphic design, layout design, illustration, photography, printing, marketing and advertising.

Gaming Design & 3D Animation

CERTIFICATIONS: AutoDesk Maya & ToonBoom

The Gaming Design and 3D Animation Program utilizes technical skills such as writing and mathematics as well as artistic skills in the development of video game content. Students will receive education in all aspects of game art and design including world design, level design, game writing, and audio integration. Students will use 2D and 3D animation to create game art that is incorporated into the game designs. Students graduating from this program go on to work in the fields of gaming design, 3D modeling, special effects, animation, storyboarding, environmental design, and broadcast design and animation (TV).
