HOW TO APPLY

- Minimum requirement includes stanines of 5 or higher (3 or higher on FCAT 2.0)* in reading and math on the most recent standardized achievement test
- 3.0 grade point average (B average) for most current school year.

* Or equivalent score on nationally normed standardized assessment/Florida Standards Assessment.

TRANSPORTATION

Arterial bus transportation (buses that operate on main roads with a limited number of stops) is provided to students who live more than two miles from the school. Magnet bus stop locations may require that parents drive their children to and from the stop.

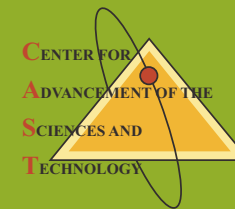
