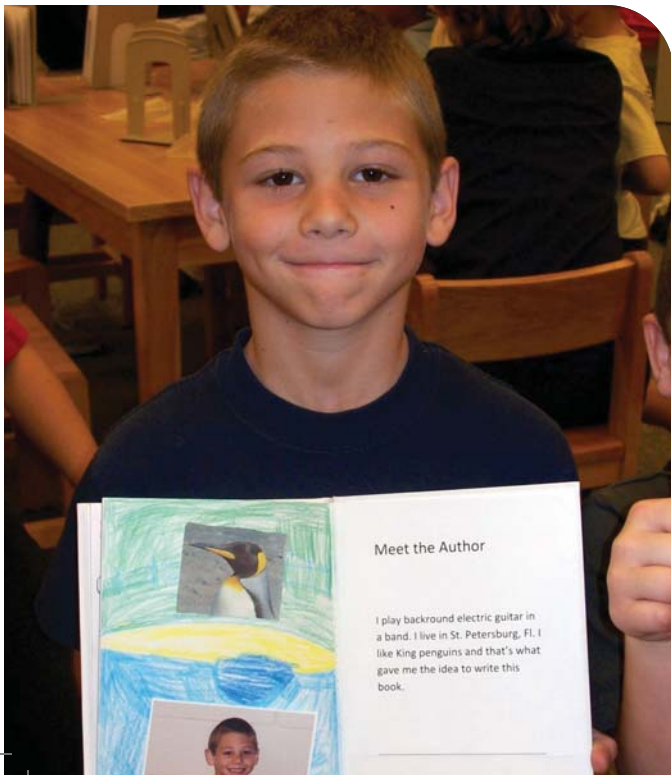

fundamental basics
