Curriculum Corner by Jeane Morehouse, Assistant Principal

This month I would like to talk about kindness. I have noticed an increase in students being unkind with their words. I would like us all to remember to help our children think about their peers and remember that other people may be experiencing difficulties that we may not know of. Let's remind our children to use words to make things better. If someone says something mean to another person, they have a choice to acknowledge it or ignore it. If one chooses to acknowledge it, they can you do it in a smart way. Say, "that's not very nice." I also tell our students that they do not have to receive unkind words, they may have to try hard but, they can ignore it. Generally, a person who calls others unkind words is trying to get attention. Let's help our children know not to give others who use unkind words attention by acknowledging mean, rude, and untrue remarks. Also, hitting in response to a rude statement will not help the situation, it will make it worse. Use words, not hands. If someone says something very egregious to your child, it's best to report that to an adult at school. I have a poster in my office with the word THINK. Each letter stands for a word that has a question to reflect upon what we say. T-Is it true? H-Is it helpful? I-Is it inspiring? N-Is it necessary? K-Is it kind? Let's have our children THINK before they say something.
