How to Find Your Child's Just Right Book

Parents often feel in the dark about helping their child select a book to read from home, the library, or the bookstore. As your child moves through the school year and gets older their reading level changes. This amazing reading growth is fantastic, but how do you help them find a *just right* book? There is an easy way to help your child choose a *just right book*...

First have your child select a book that interests them.

Next, have them open up to a random, complete page.

Then have your child read the page.

-If they make no errors or have no struggles then the book is **too easy** for them.

-If they struggle a lot with many words and it is clearly difficult then the book is **too hard**.

-If your child has about three challenges they can read through then there is a good chance you have just found your child's *just right* book.





Join us Wednesday, March 30th at 6:00PM to explore Marine Biologist Bay.





Using a Family Routine Guide for Young Children with Challenging Behavior

Children engage in challenging behavior for a variety of reasons, but all children use challenging behaviors to communicate messages. Challenging Behavior, typically, communicates a need to escape or avoid a person/activity or communicates a desire to obtain someone/something. Once parents understand the purpose or meaning of the behavior, they can begin to select strategies to change the behavior. They can do this by selecting preventative strategies, teaching new skills, and changing the way they respond in an effort to eliminate or minimize the challenging behavior (The Center on the Social and Emotional Foundations for Early Learning).

The Family Routine Guide (see link below) was developed to assist parents and caregivers in developing a plan to support young children who are using challenging behavior.
