<sup>1</sup> Meet GCU is limited to one visit per person. Attendees who live in the state of Arizona but reside outside of Maricopa County can apply for travel reimbursement of \$100. Travel restrictions may apply for out-of-state attendees based on location and availability.

<sup>2</sup> Guests who arrive the day before the event are provided dinner and breakfast at the hotel. Guests who arrive the day of the event are provided a continental breakfast at the event. All guests are provided lunch at the event. Guests who stay the night following the event are provided dinner at the hotel.

<sup>3</sup> Travel reimbursement is only available to students who demonstrate their ability to meet admissibility for the traditional campus, plus one legal guardian, from a student's home city/state to Phoenix, AZ. School/district/organizations staff, faculty and/or personnel are also eligible. To participate, the program requires a signed MOU by both the student and parent/guardian or personnel, approval of travel dates by GCU and receipts submitted per GCU requirements. Travel reimbursement thresholds vary based on location and education sector. Only one form of travel will be reimbursed, air or ground. GCU does not reimburse hotel expenses, baggage costs, early check-in or travel insurance fees. Travel reimbursement usually occurs within 45 days.
