

Stipend Information and Guidelines

Instructional Staff

Long-Term Substitutes (requires HR check)

Professional Development courses may qualify for a stipend incentive if conducted outside of the individual's contractual day and meets various criteria outlined in this document. Trade time, contracted services, or TDEs cannot be used in conjunction with a stipend incentive. Stipend payments cannot be interchanged with trade time after original issue. Verification of Professional Development requires confirmation of attendance. Participation and completion of all training tasks and assignments are required to receive the stipend.

What Professional Development is eligible?	What training, events, and activities are not eligible?
 Professional Development conducted outside contracted day District-approved components Synchronous portions of blended courses such as those that take place in-person or facilitated through online platforms (Microsoft Teams, Zoom, WebEx, etc.) 	 Asynchronous online courses Asynchronous portions of blended courses such as self-paced online (Moodle, Canvas) or independent tasks outside of the in-person training hours. Any non-certification workshop, class, meeting, conference, seminar, etc. Training completed during the contractual workday Training completed and compensated with trade or comp time Non-PCS workshop/conference/seminar Time used to complete class requirements beyond seat time University/College coursework Collegial meetings, information seminars, committee participation/meetings, conferences Training completed with a TDE on a workday Retirement Seminars, Wellness Seminars Endorsement courses

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

How do Long-Term Substitutes get approved for stipend?

The instructor who processes the roster should contact HR – Sub Team to confirm long-term substitute status. If confirmed as a Long-Term Sub follow the same process as instructional staff.

Why aren't asynchronous courses or portions of courses available for stipend pay?

Stipends can only be paid for hours worked outside of the contract day. The number of hours worked asynchronously will not be monitored by the instructor.

Can I receive a stipend for attending a mandated training sponsored/presented by an outside vendor?

Yes, those courses would fall under "District-approved components" and be paid a stipend.

Why am I not able to receive a stipend for endorsement courses?

Endorsement courses are required by the state and a service we provide. It is still eligible for Trade Days.
