Community Health Centers of Pinellas is providing a Rapid COVID Testing solution for Pinellas County Schools as we start the new school year. The testing may be available same day, within 20 minutes if rapid testing occurs.

- Testing is <u>only</u> for Pinellas County School Employees & Students
- Parent or Guardian must accompany children <u>under</u> the age of 18



Step 1:	Arrive at testing site & park near "Fast-Track Testing" signs. Please remain in your vehicle.
Step 2:	Call the phone number listed on the "Fast- Track" signs (this will notify the testing team that you have arrived for testing). Again, please remain in your vehicle.
Step 3:	CHCP Team will come directly to your vehicle to collect Photo ID & Insurance Card (if applicable). Registration & Consent Forms will be provided and collected once complete.
↓	
Step 4:	You will have a video visit with a provider who will ask you a few COVID screening questions and order the appropriate test.
Step 5:	CHCP Team will come directly to vehicle for testing. COVID testing is done via nasal swab.
Step 6:	A rapid COVID test may be ordered. If the rapid test is negative, a PCR (Nasopharyngeal swab) may be collected and sent to the lab for Confirmation.

Step 7:	Any additional TEST Results: Remain in vehicle until you receive a phone call with your results if a rapid test is performed. Results <u>must</u> be obtained in the Patient Portal. An email will be sent to the email address provided in the registration documents inviting you to sign up for the portal. Follow the link in the email to sign up. Results can be viewed and printed from the portal.
