

1. Click the "Florida Shines" Link under Learning Resources





 Scroll down the page under the heading High School Academic Progress Evaluation and click on the Start your High School Academic Progress Evaluation. link to get started.




3. Select Pinellas from the drop down for District. Enter the last name of the student. Lastly, enter the Florida Student Identifier Number*, which is the student Social Security number with an X at the end or a 10-digit number provided by your school. Click Submit.





4. Click on the "My Progress" Tab to review the student's overall graduation status. This tab will show the student's unweighted GPA, a gauge for approximately how close the student is to meeting graduation requirements, and the progress the student is making meeting the course requirements for graduation. Note: Courses that are in progress will show as complete and may change if the student is not successful.




5. Click on the "Select another evaluation" drop down located at the top right of the screen to have the student's courses evaluated for college and/or career readiness.






2. Clicking on the "Achievements" tab will highlight if the student has completed the online requirement, World Language courses if college bound, etc.



3. Click on the "Courses Taken" tab to review the student's course history including the courses the student is currently in progress with.




4. Click on the "GPA Requirements" tab to learn more about where the student's GPA is in comparison with graduation and admission with the Florida State University Systems schools.
