What is a LiveFree! Club?

LiveFree! Clubs collaborate with the coalition to share the message of living a healthy life. This is accomplished through community activism, education and social events.

- ★ *Activism*—activities and legislation to end underage alcohol, tobacco and other drug abuse in schools and communities.
- ★ *Education*— share information with youth and adults at school or in the community, by giving presentations, inviting guest speakers, organizing awareness days, and conducting workshops.
- ★ *Social Events* - build relationships between club members and support peers not using alcohol, prescription drugs, marijuana, tobacco or other drugs by hosting or attending drug-free events and celebrations.
