College Scholarship Opportunity for 6-9 grade students!

Applications are being accepted for the Pinellas Education Foundation's Take Stock in Children Scholarship Program

Candidates <u>MUST</u> be on Free/Reduced Lunch (cafeteria letter required to apply), attend a Pinellas County public middle or high school, have good grades, behavior and attendance for the past 12 months AND families <u>MUST</u> submit online application and meet USDA Federal Income Guidelines (see back for USDA Federal Income Guidelines).







Take Stock in Children currently serves **more than 8,500 students** statewide in all **67** Florida counties.

More than **2,000,000 volunteer hours** are donated by approximately **10,000 volunteer mentors**.







There are more than **1,450 TSIC graduates** that are now achieving success at many of our Florida colleges and universities.

There are approximately **40,000 students** in Pinellas County who are eligible for TSIC Scholarships.







96% of Take Stock in Children students graduate high school and enroll in college.

67% of those students go on to complete college.

These numbers **far exceed the averages** for at-risk students.







Foundation Take Stock in Children scholars receive three invaluable A's.







A Scholarship - A tuition-only Florida Prepaid College Scholarship, which can be used at any university, college, or vocational/technical school that accepts financial aid. (Value — up to 120 state college credit hours)







A Mentor - A volunteer mentor who will meet with your child bi-weekly at school, to assist and encourage your child to achieve their highest potential.







A College Success Coach - A Take Stock staff person who will help your child design a college success plan and guide them through middle and high school, and transition into college.

• A Florida Prepaid tuition scholarship upon high school graduation










TAKE STOCK IN CHILDREN MENTORING MODEL










Student Qualifications – Pre-selection









Contract Process



- Each student signs a contract agreeing to maintain GPA, good attendance and good behavior; remain drug and crime free; and meet with his/her mentor regularly.
- Parents promise to support and encourage their children's academic success.


 Upon completion of high school, students receive up to a 4 year Florida Prepaid tuition scholarship to any FAFSA approved college, technical school or university.







College Readiness Meetings with College Success Coach










Non-Compliance Conference Process
