School Advisory Council (SAC) Composition

Florida School Code 1001.452 requires that School Advisory Council members be "representative of the ethnic, racial and economic community served by the school. Magnet, fundamental and career academy programs must use the school's "application area" to determine the appropriate "community" composition. All other schools can use their "attendance zone" for this purpose.

A majority of the School Advisory Council members (at least 51%) cannot be employees of the district. The School Board, through its policy delegation to principals, reserves the right to review the composition of each council to ensure that it properly represents the school community and to appoint additional members to do so, if necessary.

The Office of the Commissioner of Education "shall determine if schools have maximized their efforts to include on their advisory councils minority persons and persons of lower socioeconomic status."

No funds shall be released for any purpose from the Educational Enhancement Trust Fund to any school district in which one or more schools do not have an approved school improvement plan or do not comply with School Advisory Council membership composition requirements pursuant to Florida School Code 1008.345(6) (c).

Pinellas County School Board Policy states that the SAC bylaws shall indicate the procedure for electing and appointing council members.

All members of this school's School Advisory Council were elected or selected as outlined in Florida School Code 1001.542.
