- Game Design: Working in teams, students will become the storytellers, artists, programmers, publishers and players by first, physically building their game and then, putting it into an online format.
- Electronic Re-engineering: In teams, students will explore the inner workings of old electronics to re-engineer a prototype to solve a real-world problem or create their own invention.
- STEM Challenges: Working in teams, students will be given daily tasks of completing grade-specific hands-on challenges.

Campers will be engaged in teamwork each day with each activity. Doing so helps to foster the essential STEM career skills of communication, teamwork and collaboration.

For students entering 6th and 7th grades during the upcoming 2018-2019 school year. This is not an advanced camp, beginner level STEM learners welcomed! Campers will become immersed into STEM concepts by engaging in the following:

- Robotics: In teams, students will become mechanical engineers and programmers by building a Makeblock mbot ultimate 2.0 robot and using mblock programming software to control and program a robot.
- Game Design: Working in teams, students will utilize Scratch programming to create digital games, apps and animation.
- Electronic Re-engineering: In teams, students will explore the inner workings of old electronics to re-engineer a prototype to solve a real-world problem.
- STEM Challenges: Working in teams, students will be given daily tasks of completing grade-specific hands-on challenges.

Campers will be engaged in teamwork each day with each activity. Doing so helps to foster the essential STEM career skills of communication, teamwork and collaboration.
