Teachers receive information of all the students that scored a Level 1 or 2 on the FCAT in Math and/or Reading. We have Data Chat meetings with the teachers to discuss the progress of students. All students that received a Level 1 or 2 on the FCAT in Math and/or Reading receive interventions. They are enrolled in Intensive classes.
