

OAKHURST ELEMENTARY SIP 2013-14 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Oakhurst Elementary School has 713 students grades Pre-K to 5th grade, one Principal and one Assistant Principal, 63 teachers and 34 support staff members. In supporting Pinellas County Schools District vision of 100% student success, our school mission is to be a community of caring mentors who are committed to motivating students to become lifelong learners and productive citizens by promoting “The Mustang Way”, Respect, Responsibility and Honesty.

The following school improvement goals will support us in reaching a vision of 100% student success:

- 1) Increase the number of parents logging into FOCUS from 60% to 65%.
- 2) Increase the percentage of students scoring a Level 3 or above in Reading from 69% to 73% as measured by the 2013-2014 FCAT 2.0.
- 3) Increase the percentage of students scoring a Level 3.5 or above in Writing from 61% to 71% as measured by the 2013-2014 Writing FCAT.
- 4) Increase the percentage of students scoring a Level 3 or above in Math from 60% to 66% as measured by the 2013-2014 FCAT 2.0.
- 5) Increase the percentage of students scoring a Level 3 or above from 57% to 65% in Science as measured by the 2013-2014 FCAT 2.0.
- 6) Increase the percentage of African American students that meet grade level expectations in Reading from 33% to 39% and in Math from 22% to 30% as measured by FCAT 2.0.

The following strategies are outlined in our action plans to support instruction in core curriculum areas: provide training to instructional staff on common core, effective instructional strategies and best practices; schedule TDE's and/or coverage for teachers to analyze data, observe and plan collaboratively; organize before and/or after school learning programs for student remediation and enrichment focusing on core subject areas.
