



### BLUE JAYS CONSTRUCTION NOTES - 2/19/19

Start date is April 2019, with a target completion date of February 2020.

Work will take place from 7am-7pm from Monday to Saturday. Construction traffic will run from Sunset point to Douglas, which is important because Milwaukee, where many parents enter and exit, will not be effected.

Because of the expansion, the parking lot will eventually be moving closer to the school. The Beltrees parking lot will be expanded further east.

The stadium capacity will go from currently holding 5500 to holding 8500.

They will add an autograph alley to the stadium to add closer access to the players.

They vow to work with the principal to help keep noise down ESPECIALLY during testing days. Mr. Knight has already given them the testing schedule.

The contract with the Blue Jays is 25 years with a 15 game minimum annually.

Mr. Knight is working on PTA meeting parking alternatives.

The stadium is working on partnering with Jolly Trolley to help shuttle fans from the parking garage and downtown Dunedin to the stadium.

The Project Manager has worked on 7 other projects near school zones. He wanted to relay his commitment to student safety. EVERY construction employee has been vetted via background checks and they have monitors on them at all times for safety and tracking reasons.

There will still be a fence barrier between the school and the stadium.

The project manager has a zero tolerance policy for his employees interacting with the public. Meaning they are not allowed to ever interact with anyone on our campus.

The noise decibel level for the city is 65 decibels and they will not violate that.
