<b>PLUMBER APPRENTICE</b>
<b>REPORTS TO:</b> Director, Pinellas Technical College
<b>SUPERVISES:</b> N/A
<b>QUALIFICATIONS:</b> Graduation from high school or possession of a GED, plus 300 hours minimum skill-specific classroom instruction from Pinellas Technical College, possession of an OSHA 10-hour safety card and possession of refrigerant certification. Possession of a valid state of Florida Class E noncommercial driver's license and any other license as may be required by law.
<b>MAJOR FUNCTION</b>
Performs semi-skilled work in installation, repair, and maintenance of plumbing systems. Assists journeyman plumber in major repairs and performs minor repairs of water, waste disposal, gas, steam heat and refrigeration systems with minimum supervision. Work is performed under general direction and reviewed upon completion for conformity with construction and established standards.
<b>ESSENTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Assists journeyman-plumber with jobs requiring advanced technical plumbing knowledge and skills.</li><li>• Makes general repairs to existing installations of water, gas, steam, waste disposal, sprinkler systems, and other plumbing installations; installs or assists in installing plumbing systems in buildings</li><li>• Replaces, cleans, and makes repairs to flush valves and faucets; does lead caulking; wipes and tests lead joints; removes stoppage from sewer lines; cuts, seams and threads pipe; makes pipe frames and railings</li><li>• Prepares layouts and sketches of plumbing to be installed; inspects sanitary and other plumbing installations for needed repairs</li><li>• Performs manual work in related rates; lifts heavy objects on a routine basis</li><li>• May keep simple records and prepare reports as required</li><li>• Performs other related duties as required</li></ul>
<b>TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT</b>
<p><i>Salary and benefits shall be paid consistent with the district's approved compensation plan. For this apprentice position, a 3.2 percent salary increase will be provided after 6 months of continuous employment in this position. In addition, after 18 months of program participation, an additional 3.2 percent salary increase will be provided until completion of the apprenticeship program. Once the skill-specific classroom instruction from Pinellas Technical College is completed, the individual is eligible for employment at the minimum salary level for the Plumber position. Length of the work year and hours of employment shall be established by the District.</i></p> <p><i>Performance of the job will be evaluated in accordance with provisions of the School Board's policy on evaluation of personnel.</i></p> <p><i>The above statements are intended to describe the general nature and level of work being performed by employees assigned to this classification.
