<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Develops, analyzes, and executes the annual food and nutrition budget and related financial statements and records for all food service programs. • Ensures there are adequate funds for programs within the department. • Evaluates the relationships between major program changes and the financial status of the department. • Employs cost-benefit analysis to review financial requests, assess program tradeoffs and explore alternative funding methods. • Prepares and evaluate monthly profit and loss statements for overall program and individual cost centers within food and nutrition. • Provides financial advice to food and nutrition administrators. • Provides leadership for budget preparation, formulation, presentation and execution. • Efficiently allocates limited financial resources. • Examines past budgets. • Estimates future financial needs. • Evaluates the performance of a program and adjust funding if necessary. • Drafts food and nutrition financial policies and procedures. • Conducts training regarding food and nutrition financial policies and procedures. • Serves as liaison between food and nutrition, budget and finance offices and other related departments. • Supervises personnel as assigned. • Participates in professional development/training and maintains the hours required by USDA for professional standards. • Performs other related duties as assigned.
