MAJOR FUNCTION

The Resource Teacher, FDLRS, is responsible for implementing FDLRS Gulfcoast Associate Center Discretionary Project activities by providing support services to school and district staff, parents/families, and community partners, in Pinellas, Pasco and Hernando Counties who are involved in the education of students with disabilities ages 0-21. The resource teacher will be responsible for FDLRS Gulfcoast activities in the FDLRS service area.

ESSENTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Performs activities required by the Florida Department of Education as part of the FDLRS discretionary project to support state initiatives.
- Provides input to the FDLRS Specialist regarding the preparation and application planning in addition to the ongoing activities for the FDLRS Gulfcoast service area.
- Assists with the implementation of FDLRS Gulfcoast activities which will include local, regional, and state travel and may include early or late departures as well overnight stay.
- Plans, conducts, and coordinates training and technical assistance for FDLRS Gulfcoast service area stakeholders involved in the education of exceptional students including exceptional educators, parents, general educators, district personnel, private school personnel and community agency personnel.
- Assists in the maintenance of active public relations with the community and promotes awareness of exceptional student education programs and FDLRS services.
- Assists in the dissemination of information relevant to the education of students with disabilities.
- Provides support to districts to assist in the successful integration of current and emerging assistive and instructional technology into the instructional program for students with disabilities.
- Participates in Child Find activities to assist the local school district with locating and identifying unserved, unenrolled children suspected of needing exceptional student education.
- Provides service to stakeholders during summer hours, evening hours, and weekends as needed to provide required activities on a 12-month basis.
- Collects and maintains data in local and state databases.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.
