Five (5) years related professional experience.
MAJOR FUNCTION	
The Threat Management Coordinator is responsible for overseeing the district's threat management process to include developing procedures and training appropriate staff. Coordinates, attends and participates in all district-level threat assessments and follow-up meetings with student services staff who provide mental health services to students, as needed.	
ESSENTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Leads and manages district threat management team and processes. Oversees monitoring of threat management team recommendations. Coordinate with student services team to deliver mental health services based upon student need. Develops processes and criteria for various settings and communicates to affected stakeholders. Provides training and support to school-based threat management teams. Prepares all required reports and maintains all appropriate records. Maintains current knowledge and updates regarding applicable rules, policies, procedures, contracts, State and Federal laws, codes, and regulations. Conducts professional development training for faculty, staff, parents, and community. Coordinates, conducts, or participates in a variety of meetings, staff development, committees, trainings, workshops, and/or conferences. Represents the School District at local, regional, state, and community meetings. Assesses impact of legislation, state board rule and policy as it related to mental health, safety, and alternative placements. Serves on district, state, and community councils or committees. Gathers input from staff, schools, parents, and community. Develops and monitors program processes and services based on the needs of students, teachers, administrators, families, businesses, and community. Keeps informed and disseminates information about current research, trends and best practices in areas of responsibility. Acts in a professional and ethical manner and always adheres to the Professional Code of Ethics. Performs other related duties as assigned.
