## Fourth Grade Suggested Supply List

- 2 Composition Books** – (If possible, one red, one yellow, – Color Specific to Coordinate with Subjects)
- 8 Pocket Folders with clasps** (Not the Plastic ones – Color Specific to Coordinate with Subjects) 1 yellow + 1 Blue + 1 Red + 1 Orange + 1 Purple + 3 Green
- 3 Packs of Notebook Paper** – College Ruled
- 1 Pack of Coloring Pencils**
- 1 Binder** – 3 Ring – 2 inches with side pockets (No bigger than 2 in.)
- 1 Scissors**
- 4 (total) Dry Erase Markers** –Expo, Low odor, Black
- 2 packs of #2 pencils**
- 1 pack of erasers**
- 1 Black Ink Sharpie Permanent Marker**
- 2 Packages of Plain Copy Paper**
- 4 Stick Glue**

## Third Grade Suggested Supply List

- **1-1/2 in. clear view binder**
