Sixth Grade Electives:

Music

- Band 1: open to all 6th, 7th and 8th grade students who wish to learn how to play a band instrument.
- Band 2 (Intermediate) open to students who have at least one <u>full</u> year of band experience.
- Orchestra 1 This is an introductory class for students interested in learning violin, viola, cello or string bass.
- Orchestra 2 This class is for students with one or more years' experience, who are
 proficient in three basic scales and able to sight read Level E literature.
- Choir 1 This is the first-year choir class, open to students with no previous choral experience

Computers

- Information & Communication Technology 1 A yearlong computer course that is an introduction to Core Computer Concepts, software, programing and lower level certifications.
- Computer Applications in Business 1 A semester course that focuses on intermediate keyboarding, Word, Power Point, introduction to Excel and digital design and lower level certifications.

STEM

- Intro to Manufacturing & Career Planning-Semester course where students will learn the importance of technology and manufacturing and how it applies to their personal lives.
- Exploring Technology & Career Planning- Semester course designed to be a hands-on, project-based class in which students develop problem-solving skills, a proper safety attitude, and basic skills in wood project construction.

Visual Art

• Visual Art 1 - A semester course that covers basic visual art concepts. This would be a first step towards yearlong art class in 7^{th} and 8^{th} grade.

Gifted

 Advanced Academics – The course is designed for gifted students to enrich and challenge them with rigorous material. This class is divided into three years focusing on different academic and interdisciplinary coursework.
