DIGITAL LEARNING IS... FUN! FLEXIBLE! FAMILY & TEACHER FRIENDLY!

- **Core Subjects:** Three 20-30 mins lessons/activities a day. To include ELA: reading or writing, Math & Science, Plus 1 specials (PE, Music or Art)
- **Specials**: 20-30 minutes. Visit PE Team 3 times a week and Music Team & Art Team 1 time a week.
- **ESE:** 20 minutes. Visit the Team once a week or the ESE teacher/therapist will reach out to you.
- **Gifted:** On gifted day, complete the gifted attendance activity (30 seconds). Review gifted activities for your grade level, do one activity and strive for more when you can.
- Lessons: May be live (interactive), recorded, or activities.
- Log in: Day or Night
- **Computer Time:** 2-3 hours, spread throughout the day/night. Lower minutes in primary grade levels, higher minutes in intermediate grade levels.
- Assignments: for the week are due 11:59 PM Sunday (That gives you a week to do the work)
- **Communication**: Teachers will use previously established mode of communication with families. For example: email or Dojo.
- "Live" interactive lessons: Teachers will provide by Sunday a schedule of live, interactive lessons for the week. Live lessons will be recorded & available in Teams for viewing at any time.
- **Graded Assignments**: By Sunday for the upcoming week: Teachers will communicate to parents what assignments will be "graded". This should be no more than 1 assignment/assessment per subject a week. *Parents, we do expect graded assignments/assessments to be done independently by the student. This helps teachers drive the instruction to meet the learning needs of the students.*
- Enrichment/Intervention: iStation, Dreambox and MYon are encouraged and are available in Clever. Kids are familiar with these programs. Teachers can provide Enrichment activities in Teams. (20 mins a day)
- Fun Friday!: no assignments. Find fun activities to do and/or catch up on assignments. Visit the OES
 Library Team, PE, Music, Art Teams, play a game, get some sunshine...just have FUN! GO OSPREYS!
