- Communication: Teachers will use previously established mode of communication with families. For example: email or Dojo.
- "Live" interactive lessons: If teachers plan to hold a live lesson, a schedule will be provided in advance.
- Enrichment/Intervention: Apps are available in Clever. Teachers can provide Enrichment activities in Teams.
- Fun Friday!: No assignments. Find one 1 fun activity to do and/or catch up on assignments. Visit the OES Library Team, play a game, get some sunshine...just have FUN!
