

The AVID requirements ARE:

AVID I 1 honors class
AVID II 2 honors classes
AVID III 1 honors, 1 AP

• AVID IV 2 AP or mix/match dual enrollment with an AP.

As you can see, we introduce kids in AVID I to a more rigorous coursework, they build skills and by AVID II enter into TWO honors, AVID III introduce them to AP classes while allowing them the comfort of retaining 1 honors in addition to AP, finally, AVID IV (bridging the gap between high school and college) TWO AP or Dual enrollment courses.

AVID's GPA requirement

- Freshmen/Sophomore 2.5
- Junior/Senior 2.75.
- YES, we will consider students in grade levels that do not qualify under this specific guideline, case by case.
- YES, AVID will accept students with an IEP, 504. Just as with any other student, it is based on the *student's ability to be successful in rigorous coursework*.
- YES students may enroll in AVID IV even if they were not in the program before.
- YES, students may enroll in ANY LEVEL AT ANYTIME. THIS IS A FULL YEAR COURSE, not a semester course and the county will NOT allow us to withdraw or enroll students mid semester.
- YES the application is ONLINE
- YES you may send the student to my room (building 9 room 7) and I will walk them
 through it. The most I have seen is 20 minutes to complete it. IF parents/guardians
 signed the enrollment for courses the students may apply online without additional
 parent signatures. The only form needed next year is the release for photo.
