Welcome!! I am your PTA President for the next 2 school years!!

The PTA's mission is to make every child's potential a reality by engaging and empowering families and communities to advocate for all children.

For everyone who is new, and even our returning families, I'd like to take some time to explain where the money goes that the PTA raises. Our only 2 fundraisers are our Read-a-thon (coming soon) and Grand Prix (typically in the February/March time frame). We also make a little money off membership. Things we fund are the PBIS Stores that happens every month, teacher/staff requests for materials and more for their grade level or lab. We buy the software for our pickup system and a system to help make class lists every year. We supply funding for before- or after-school clubs. We put on Snow Day and an end of year program, which has been Astro Skate for the last couple of years. We help fund field trips as well as end of the year celebrations. We put on and fund the Back-to-School Picnic and Boohoo Yahoo Breakfast as well as a welcome back breakfast for staff. We have helped support other local schools who want to start a PTA by donating money for them to pay for their insurance, which all PTAs have to have and pay for yearly.

But even more importantly, with your \$7 dollar membership we have more of a voice when things come up and laws start to form. This past summer we joined with many other PTA/PTSA and FLPTA to file a lawsuit against the government for freezing funds the day before they were to be released. We have a board member who follows these types of items as well. I also sit on the Pinellas County PTA and follow and bring back how we can help all.



#### What is the Read-A-Thon?


- One of our biggest fundraising events. Participants are encouraged to read as much as possible within the designated time frame.
